The theme of this number is focused on **Performing Arts, Media and Training**, edited by Salvatore Colazzo and Ada Manfreda (University of Salento, Italy; Università Telematica Pegaso, Italy). In the Editorial they introduce the focus.

This number includes also some *out of focus* papers accepted after a double peer review procedure.

The work of **Elba Gutiérrez-Santiuste**, **María-Jesús Gallego-Arrufat** and **Aurelio Simone** (*Barriers in computer-mediated communication: typology and evolution over time*) explores barriers in computer-mediated communication in a university collaborative learning community, specifically in a community of inquiry.

The study included in the paper by **Muhammad Anshari et al.** (*Online Learning: trends, issues and challenges in the Big Data Era*) examines recent internet activities and literacy in Brunei Darussalam relating to the internet behaviour and online learning of residents.

The article by **Abdelouahab Belazoui**, **Okba Kazar** and **Samir Bourekka-che** (*A Cooperative Multi-Agent System for modeling of authoring system in e-learning*) proposes a cooperation activity framework and its application for cooperative authoring systems.

The communication by **Zuzana Melicherikova** and **Andrej Piovarci** (*Experience with Massive Open Online Courses in Slovakia*) discusses the use of MOOCs in an education institution in Slovakia.

The last communication by **Medjon Hysenaj** (*A perspective for spatial-learning*) analyses GIS opportunities as constructive pillar for student performance in an university class.

The next number of Je-LKS (May 2016) will be dedicated to the theme *Big*

data, cognitive computing and innovative teaching models. The call for papers ends on March, 15th and includes theme like *Big data, Open data, Technology enhanced learning, Mobile learning, Big data management, platforms and analytics, Data-driven innovation, Smart cities, Smart university, Cognitive computing, Artificial intelligence, Cloud computing applications and services, Database systems.*
